

Wivenhoe Town Drain - Investigation Works

What are we telling you about?

Our work to investigate the location of buried cables and pipes.

Where is this work happening?

Over the piped section of Wivenhoe Town Drain opposite New House, Anglesea Road, Wivenhoe. The area of investigation is marked red on the plan below.

When are we doing the work?

During week commencing 13 June and lasting for up to 4 days.

What will we be doing?

Our contractor Breheny will be excavating the locations of buried cables and pipes to determine their exact location. Once complete the excavations will be filled in and the surface made good. Breheny will work with nearby residents to ensure access is maintained.

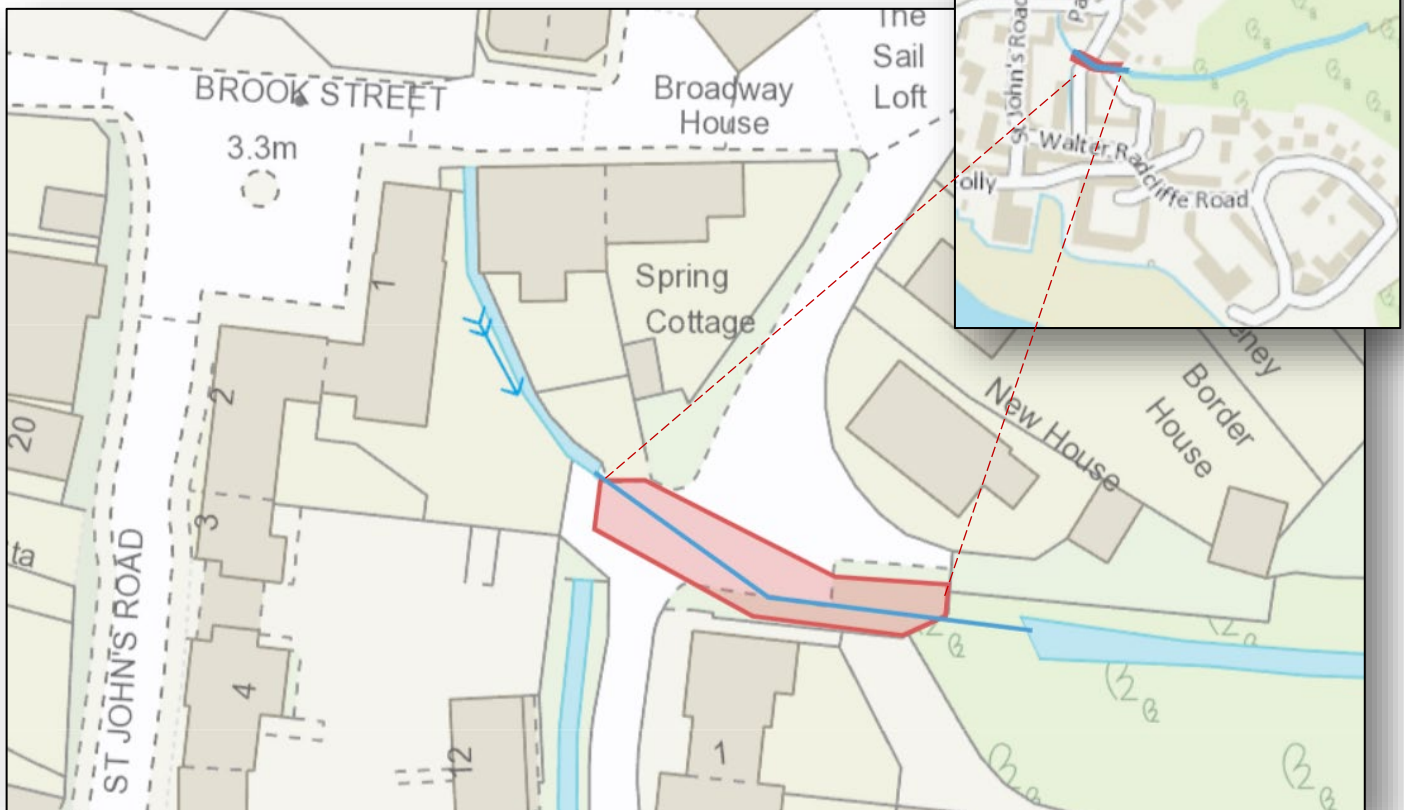
Why are we doing this work?

It is possible that if the pipes on a section of the Town Drain were to be enlarged, the risk of flooding to the Business Centre and St Johns Road could be reduced. This work will help us to determine if a project to do this is viable.
